

## SIT Notes 9/13/16

The group met and decided on the following possibility of overarching goals for the 2016-2018 SIP:

**1. Literacy:**

Positively impact student achievement by enhancing individual literacy through regular opportunity for reading in the content areas.

**2. Academic:**

Biology, Math 1, and English 2 will exceed expected growth during the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years.

- Biology will be proficient with a gain in the 2016-2017 school year, with an additional gain the following year. In addition to proficiency measures, Biology will also exceed expected growth.
- Math I will be proficient after the 2016-2017 school year, and proficient state after the 2017-2018 school year. In addition to proficiency measures, Math I will also exceed expected growth.
- English II will be proficient by 2016-2017 with a gain in each year. at the end of the 2016-2017 year, by the end of the 2017-2018 year. In addition to proficiency measures, English II will also exceed expected growth.

The group also discussed looking at composite score for the school versus looking at scores for EOCs only and decided to table this until the next meeting. Each representative is to go back to his/her department and discuss. JCHS has historically had low composite score.
