

SIT Team Notes September 8, 2016

Keeping the Staff Informed:

The group decided that we would place a folder in Schoology under the JCHS Staff page in Resources and all notes and information would be put there in order to keep staff informed of progress on SIP as well as throughout the year.

Groups discussed the following three areas for development of the 2016 SIP:

1. Teacher Working Conditions Survey: Class size is too large, not enough sufficient supplies, parents not contributing back even though they are being made aware of information, not managing conduct issues consistently, teachers not being relied on for decisions and not being treated as experts, low on professional development being specific to area, need deeper content knowledge professional development, very low in state assessments being accurate.
2. Achievement Data: School specific-EOC Math 1 scores 50% proficient but only 33% Career and College Ready. Seems we are above most of the other schools but this is an area we need to see growth in of meeting our C&CR to Proficiency.
3. SIP 2014-2016: Items to continue-
 - Continue new teachers being able to observe veteran teachers and have coverage.
 - Continue working toward the collaborative space on 2nd floor
 - Continue PD being frequent, specific and providing choice for teachers.
 - Continue 1 positive parent contact made per year for each CATS student. PLCs continue to focus on student engagement.
