Achieve 3000 –

It was discussed that we would begin promoting Achieve 3000 use with staff and we will start at the beginning of second semester. PLCs should have a conversation in their meetings regarding the usage with students. Times have opened up for Achieve 3000 so that students can begin doing it as homework and at school.

Math will use it once a week. Other subjects can use it more often. English - 1 or 2 articles per week. Each PLC has decided their own usage.

There will be a section in the weekly update about Achieve.
We will monitor the level of usage at next SIT meeting.

It was brought up in a PLC that for some subjects there are not a lot of Achieves related to specific topics. It was discussed for groups to try to find something near subject area but that other topics are fine as well. It would be more beneficial for students to do any type of Achieve with the hopes to improve their reading levels and lexile scores.

Supplies –

Corey has a system but said there are a lot of questions about who will fill requests and how it will work.

The group discussed expectations on how much and how often supplies should be available, and what the process should be for getting them. The majority of supplies are to be bought with commissioner money, and the supply closet in the office should be used for emergency supplies.

It was decided that if a teacher needs an emergency item they are to fill out the form (Corey McNeill will make this form), and turn it in to their administrator. Mrs. Barnhardt will have the office assistants fill the request and put it in the teacher's box.

Corey McNeill will present the supply process as well as the wish list process at the next staff meeting in February.
